Subject: Downtown Sign Ordinance,

Text Addition

Purpose

For the purpose of amending the Zoning Ordinance in order to revise existing provisions.

Ordinance

Whereas, under the provisions of Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Town Council of Leonardtown for Leonardtown, Maryland, is empowered to adopt, revise and amend the Leonardtown Zoning Ordinance; and

Whereas, the current Downtown Sign Ordinance, has been amended to add Item Number 5, Waiver and Modifications.

5. Waivers and Modifications

The Planning and Zoning Commission may waive or modify the above provisions on a case-by-case basis. The Commission may allow waivers only when it finds that such a waiver does not harm the environment or violate the spirit of this ordinance.

The Downtown Sign Ordinance appears in its entirety in Schedule A attached.


