

Ordinance
No. 14

An Ordinance to prohibit all disturbances of the peace, disorderly conduct, drunkenness, swearing or the use of obscene language, obstructing or hindering the free passage of persons along the public streets or highways, and any indecent exposure, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for the violation of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that any person who shall wilfully disturb the public peace, or the peace of any neighborhood, by loud and unseemly or unreasonable or unnecessary noises or who shall profanely curse and swear or use obscene language, or who shall be found drunk or acting in a disorderly manner by making loud or unseemly noises, or by profanely cursing or swearing or using obscene language, or by indecently exposing their person, or who wilfully obstruct or hinder the free passage of persons passing along or by any of the public streets or highways, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, shall upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to a fine of not less than \$5.00 and costs, nor more than \$25.00 and costs, and if such fine and costs be not paid, the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a period not exceeding 25 days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this ordinance shall take effect from the
