

Ordinance  
No. 16

An Ordinance to regulate the erection of buildings or additions to buildings, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, the granting of permits therefor and providing a penalty for violations of the same.

WHEREAS, The Commissioners of Leonardtown desire to preserve and protect the health, safety and well being of the inhabitants of Leonardtown, Maryland, the following Ordinance is passed and adopted by the Commissioners of Leonardtown:

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, that no person, persons, firm or corporation, shall erect any building, or any additions to buildings, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, without first making an application and receiving a permit to do so from the Commissioners of Leonardtown, and all applications for permits shall be in writing, stating the proposed location, the size of the proposed building, or addition to a building, and the materials to be used in its construction, as well as the purpose for which it is to be used; and person, persons, firm or corporation, who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance, shall be, upon conviction, fined the sum of \$100.00 and costs, and the further sum of \$5.00 for each and every day from the date that the building is commenced, and in default of fine shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail until such fine or fines are paid, not exceeding, however, the term of Sixty days.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this ordinance shall take effect from the
