An Ordinance to prohibit the removal of dirt, gravel, cement, asphalt or other street building materials from any of the streets, sidewalks, alleyways or road ways within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, except with the permission of the Commissioners of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for any violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that no dirt, gravel, cement, asphalt or other street building materials shall be taken from or disturbed on any of the streets, sidewalks, alleyways or roadways within the Corporate Limits of Leonardtown, except with the permission of the Commissioners of Leonardtown first having been obtained, provided that any individual or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$\frac{1.00}{},\text{ and costs, nor more than \$\frac{10.00}{},\text{ and costs, and when said fine and costs are not paid, the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a term not exceeding 10 days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

And be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
