

ORDINANCE  
NO. 31

An Ordinance to provide for the creation of a Board of Appeals to be known as "Leonardtown Board of Appeals", as provided by section 22 of Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957) as amended.

Section 1:

Whereas, by Section 22 of Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957), as amended, the Commissioners of Leonardtown were authorized and empowered, among other things, to create a Board of Appeals to be appointed by said Commissioners of Leonardtown.

Section 2:

Therefore, be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, this 4th day April, 1967, that a Board of Appeals is hereby created to be known as "Leonardtown Board of Appeals" to consist of three members. The term of office of the members of the Board shall be three years. Members of the Board shall be appointed by the Commissioners of Leonardtown and shall be removable for cause, upon written charges, and after public hearing. Vacancies shall be filled by the Commissioners of Leonardtown for the unexpired terms of any member whose term becomes vacant.

Section 3:

The Leonardtown Board of Appeals shall possess all of the powers and duties as set forth in Article 66B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957), as amended.

Section 4:

And be it further enacted that this Ordinance shall take effect as of the date of its passage and enactment.
