

Ordinance  
No 8.

An Ordinance to prohibit the playing of any games in any of the Public Streets, Sidewalks, Alleyways, Roadways, or Parks within the Corporate Limits of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that no person shall play any games in any of the Public Streets, or on any of the Public Sidewalks, Alleyways, Roadways or Parks, within the Corporate Limits of Leonardtown; provided that any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 and costs, nor more than \$5.00 and costs, and when said fine and costs are not paid, the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a term not exceeding five days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance take effect from the date of its passage.
