

Ordinance  
No. 13

An Ordinance to prohibit all pyrotechnic displays, the shooting of fire works of any kind, and all unreasonable and unnecessary shooting of firearms of any kind, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, except with the permission of the Commissioners of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, that no pyrotechnic displays shall be held, nor any fireworks be shot or exploded, nor shall any fire arms be shot unnecessarily or unreasonably, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, except with the permission of the Commissioners of Leonardtown; provided that any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 and costs, nor more than \$10.00 and costs, and in default of fine the party convicted shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a period not exceeding Ten (10) days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
