

Ordinance
No. 4

An Ordinance to prohibit the obstruction of sidewalks, alleyways and roadways, and the entrances and exits to and from private property from said sidewalks, alleyways and roadways, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, that no sidewalk, alleyway or roadway, or private entrance or exit to or from said sidewalks, alleyways or roadways, within the corporate limits of Leonardtown shall be obstructed in any manner; provided, that any individual firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$ 1.00 and costs, nor more than \$ 25.00 and costs, and when said fine and costs are not paid, the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a term not exceeding 30 days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

And be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this Ordinance shall become effective from the date of its passage.
