REQUIREMENTS

EFFECTIVE DATE: JUNE 14, 1988

TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE REQUIRING PARKING  
FOR MARINAS

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance of Leonardtown stipulates on premises parking lot requirements to ensure that adequate parking is provided as the Town grows,

WHEREAS, there are no parking lot requirements for marinas in the existing Ordinance,

WHEREAS, parking lot requirements for marinas are necessary, in order to anticipate future waterfront development,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN, this thirteenth day of June 1988 that the following Amendment is hereby adopted within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, Maryland, to be added to the Leonardtown Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 13-4 MARINA PARKING REQUIREMENTS


One parking space must be provided per two marina boat slips.




