Single-Stream Recycling

What Makes It Easy? No More Sorting.

With single-stream recycling, all recyclable items are placed in the same container and collected without the resident or the contractor having to sort or separate them. If you do not have a recycling container or need additional ones, use cardboard boxes or any receptacle marked with an "X", so contractors can distinguish it from your regular trash. (Cardboard boxes will be collected along with their content).

- Paper Board and Corrugated Cardboard
- * Books

Unacceptable Items:

Margarine Tubs, Yogurt Containers, Styrofoam Packing Peanuts, Bubble Wrap, Plastic Utensils, Light Bulbs, broken Glass, Windowpanes & Mirrors, Motor Oil & Antifreeze Containers, Auto Parts, Medical Waste, Hazardous Waste
