## Dear Beach Party Participant:

The Leonardtown Business Association and the Commissioners of Leonardtown are sponsoring Leonardtown's 13<sup>th</sup> Annual "*Beach Party on the Square*" event on Saturday, August 2, 2014 from 4:00 PM until 9:00 PM. This family-oriented event features live music and a variety of exciting entertainment, activities, games and fun!

Vendor participation is welcome at this event; and Community agencies are also welcome to set up a freestanding exhibit and educate the public about their organization.

However, exhibitors and vendors should have displays and items for sale that would **appeal directly to the Beach Party audience** – particularly pertaining to sun, sand or water; beach towels, flip flops, beach clothing (cover ups), and other fun, colorful accessories; luau and tropical themed items or beach toys; sun screen, visors, sunglasses, etc.

Exhibitors should a to have an **interactive activity** at their space to enhance our visitors' experience and help draw people to their tables.

The Leonardtown Business Association charges a nominal \$45 fee per space for vendors and exhibitors participating in the Beach Party event. **These fees are non-refundable** and will be applied towards the cost of sponsoring the event.

Assigned vendor space is approximately 10' X 12'. Vendors are responsible for supplying their own materials, tables and chairs, and are **strongly encouraged** to bring a pop-up tent or umbrella for cover, which also brings a look of uniformity to the event. If electricity is requested, an additional fee of \$25 is required. There are a limited number of spaces with electricity, and they will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. **Electricity fees are also non-refundable.** 

To request space as a vendor or exhibitor in this event, return the enclosed Vendor/Exhibitor Application **no later than July 11, 2014** along with the required vendor fee and certificate of liability insurance if required. First time vendors should also supply a photo of their product. Any vendor selling food must obtain a permit from the St. Mary's County Health Department.

The Leonardtown Business Association reserves the right to accept or reject any applicant based on product duplication, prior vendor performance, desirability of the product, or if the applicant does not meet the specified theme, criteria or quality, and further reserves the right to remove any booth, display, or work deemed inappropriate the day of the event. There will be no guarantee to exclusive rights to sales of specific items or products.
