

RESOLUTION #2 - 65

A Resolution to amend the Charter of the Town of Leonardtown to authorize the Commissioners of Leonardtown to provide for the regulation, licensing and taxing of trailers, trailer coaches, mobile homes and trailer coach Parks in the Town of Leonardtown.

Section 1: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN, That the Charter of the Town of Leonardtown be amended by adding the following provisions thereto:

The Commissioners of Leonardtown shall have the power to pass all such ordinances not contrary to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Maryland OR of the Town Charter as they may deem necessary for the regulation and licensing of vehicles, vehicle trailers, automobile trailer coaches, mobile homes, or similar structures so designed and constructed as to permit occupancy thereof as sleeping quarters for one or more persons or the conduct of any business, trade, profession, or occupation, or use as a selling or advertising device, and so designed that they are or may be mounted on wheels and transported over highways and streets, propelled or drawn by their own OR other motive power. The Commissioners of Leonardtown also shall have the power to pass all such ordinances not contrary to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Maryland or of the Town Charter as they may deem necessary FOR THE regulation and licensing of parks, trailer parks, trailer courts, trailer coach parks, courts, camps, sites, lots, parcels, plots, or tracts of land designed, maintained or intended for the purpose of supplying a location or accommodations for any trailer coach or trailer

coaches occupied for dwelling or sleeping purposes and upon which any trailer coach or trailer coaches are parked, including all buildings used or intended for use as a part of the equipment thereof whether a charge is made for the use of the trailer coach park and its facilities or not.  
The Commissioners of Leonardtown also shall have the power to provide penalties for violation of any such ordinances passed and approved pursuant hereto.

Section 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN, That this Resolution shall take effect upon the expiration of fifty (50) days following its final passage.
