The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company has applied to the Public Service Commission of Maryland to increase its rates for telephone services.


Inasmuch as only fifteen months prior to this application the Public Service Commission granted a rate increase to the Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company, the Commissioners of Leonardtown, Maryland (legislative body) are greatly interested in the reasons The Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company has for applying for another rate increase so soon after the last rate increase.
