

ADOPTION AND RATIFICATION OF TOWN PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

Resolution No. 10 (3)

WHEREAS, Chapter 64 of the 1971 Laws of Maryland made significant changes in the law of Maryland as the same applies to land use, zoning and subdivision control.

WHEREAS, the new law makes for and provides Transitional Provisions.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown are desirous of the Leonardtown Planning and Zoning Commission being constituted in accordance with the provisions of said act, with all powers, duties, rights and responsibilities granted thereby.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved and ordained that there be, as the same is presently constituted by membership and term of office, a Planning and Zoning Commission of Leonardtown, with all rights, responsibilities, powers and duties as is provided under existing Maryland Law, and any amendments thereto which might hereafter be made.
