A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE WITHHOLDING BY THE COUNTY CLERK OF A NEW BUSINESS LICENSE UNTIL CERTIFICATION HAS BEEN OBTAINED FROM THE COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN, MARYLAND THAT THE APPLICANT HAS OBTAINED ALL NECESSARY ZONING APPROVALS AND OCCUPANCY PERMITS.

Whereas the adherence to local zoning requirements contributes to the general health and well being of all residents of Leonardtown, and

Whereas a number of new businesses have been granted licenses to operate within the corporate limits of Leonardtown without compliance of necessary zoning approvals,

Now therefore be it resolved that the Commissioners of Leonardtown hereby request that the Clerk of the Circuit Court for St. Mary's County shall, effective Monday, May 3, 1982, refuse to honor any request to issue a new business license within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, Maryland until such time as the Commissioners of Leonardtown/and or their staff shall submit to the Clerk certification that the applicant has obtained all necessary zoning approvals.
