## **RESOLUTION NO. 7-82**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BORROWING OF CERTAIN FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN EXPENSES FOR THE LEONARDTOWN WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that the Leonardtown Commissioner duly appointed to manage and direct the public utilities is hereby empowered to borrow from The First National Bank of St. Mary's a principal sum not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days.
