

RESOLUTIONTOWN COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN

WHEREAS, the 1986 General Assembly of the State of Maryland passed the Minimum Livability Code, which sets minimum maintenance standards for rental housing in Maryland, and it becomes binding on all political subdivisions of the State, which do not have local housing codes which substantially conform with the State Code on January 1, 1989

WHEREAS, funding has been made available by the Division of Local Government Assistance of the Department of Economic and Community Development to assist political subdivisions in adopting and implementing a minimum livability code.

WHEREAS, it would be of benefit to both the Town of Leonardtown and St. Mary's County to jointly adopt and implement a Minimum Livability Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this eleventh day of May, 1987 that the Town Commissioners of Leonardtown authorize the St. Mary's County Commissioners to act as applicant for the Livability Code Implementation Program, with the assurance that the Town of Leonardtown will receive a proportionate share of program benefits commensurate with its funding allocation.
