
COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN

WHEREAS, potable water is one of the Town of Leonardtown's most valuable resources, and


WHEREAS, the maintenance of the water lines is costly and out-of-town-customers provide no reimbursements for maintenance costs,
