

COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN

WHEREAS, on January 9, 1989 the Commissioners of Leonardtown passed Resolution 1-89 which stated as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED, this ninth day of January, 1989, the attached proposed charter be and hereby is enacted replacing and superceding the previous Charter of Leonardtown, Maryland which was enacted in 1965.

This enactment to be subject to the provisions of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Article 23 Sections 11 through 18 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

WHEREAS, it was the intention of Resolution 1-89 to repeal in its entirety, the Charter of Leonardtown, Maryland. Municipal Charters of Maryland, Chapter 87 Volume VII (1983) and to enact in place thereof the attached Charter; and

WHEREAS, to date a fair summary of the new, proposed Charter has not been posted or published as required by Maryland Code Annotated, Act 23A, Section 13(d)+(e); and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Commissioners of Leonardtown to *give ample public* notice of the enactment of the attached Charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this thirteenth day of February 1989 that Resolution 1-89 be and hereby is rescinded and repealed; and be it further,

RESOLVED, that the Charter of Leonardtown, Municipal Charters of Maryland, Chapter 87, Volume VII (1983) be and hereby is repealed in its entirety and be it further,

RESOLVED, that the attached proposed Charter be and hereby is enacted as the Charter of Leonardtown replacing and superceding in its entirety the Leonardtown Charter and be it further,

RESOLVED, that the effective date of the Charter of Leonardtown (1989) shall be April 4, 1989 provided: a fair summary of the Charter is posted and published as required by Maryland Code Annotated, Section 13(d)+(e); the Charter and of this Resolution is registered with the Department of Legislative Reference; and, no petition for referendum as provided for in Maryland Code Annotated, Article 23A Section 13(f),(g)+(h) is filed on or before March 27, 1989.
