WHEREAS, the provisions of Leonardtown's Zoning Ordinance concerning Newly Annexed Territory, Section 22-4, provides for the designating of the zoning for newly annexed territory:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this twenty-seventh day of April, 1989 by the COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN, that the tract known as the James Russell tract, St. Mary's County Commissioners/Leonard Hall tract and parcels located on Breton Bay Drive, Library Place and Calvert Road be designated Residential Single-Family; the St. Mary's Academy tract, Academy Development Company tract, and the Robert E. Wentworth tract be designated Planned Unit Development-5 and that the parcels occupied by Southern Maryland Supply and the Town of Leonardtown's Sewage Treatment Plant be designated Commercial General. The tract known as the Barbarich property will be designated as PUD-5 also.
