R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for St. Mary's County, Maryland has passed a resolution adopting the St. Mary's County Official Road Name List maintained by the Department of Planning and Zoning dated July 13, 1993 in order to implement an enhanced 911 emergency telephone system, and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of Leonardtown are desirous of affording the residents of the Town of Leonardtown with the same protection and safety as the rest of the County will receive from the enhanced 911 emergency telephone system.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 14th day of February, 1994 by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that the streets located within the Town of Leonardtown shall become part of the St. Mary's County Official Road Name List and that the Town shall participate in and become part of the enhanced 911 emergency telephone system to be implemented by the County. The Town shall appoint a representative to the committee formed by the County to implement the Official Road Name List, and said appointee shall participate in the actions of said committee so as to see that the streets of the Town of Leonardtown are included in said List as intended. Any recommendations to change the names of streets located within the Town or to change the street signs therein shall be brought before the Commissioners for approval.


