

A resolution preserving the historical heritage of Leonardtown.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Town of Leonardtown is interested in celebrating the year 2000 by preserving and fostering its historical heritage, and

WHEREAS, Alfred Gough, Jr. has volunteered to undertake the research, compilation and editing of a book concerning the history of Leonardtown from its inception through 1999 A.D.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 14th day of February, 1994, by the Mayor and Council of Leonardtown, as follows:

- (1) Through the year 2000 A.D. the Town shall place in reserve \$2,000.00 annually for the publication of said book and for the year 2000 celebration.
- (2) From the aforementioned reserve, the Town shall reimburse Alfred Gough any reasonable expenses for the procurement of goods and services obtained and expended for the research, compilation and editing of said book provided such expenditures comply with the Town's prevailing procurement policy.
- (3) The publication deadline shall be January 15, 2000 A.D.
- (4) Initial proceeds from the sale of said book shall be returned to the Town to reimburse publication and other such expenses incurred by the Town.
- (5) The Town shall receive 100 complimentary copies of the book.
- (6) Profits from the sale of the books shall be donated to the St. Mary's County Historical Society for the restoration and maintenance of Tudor Hall.
- (7) Copyrights and all other ownership privileges shall be vested with the Town of Leonardtown.


