

A resolution to amend the property tax rate.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the authority to set rates, levy and collect taxes is granted to the Commissioners of Leonardtown under the Municipal Charter, and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown after due and careful consideration have concluded that the following tax rate is fair, just, equitable and fiscally responsible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 31st day of May, 1994, by the Commissioners of Leonardtown that the property tax rate for the Town of Leonardtown for the (fiscal) year beginning July 1, 1994 be set at a rate of 37 cents per one hundred dollars of the assessed valuation of the property.
