

COMMISSIONERS OF LEONARDTOWN


A RESOLUTION TO DELEGATE TO THE COMMUNITY POLICE OFFICER THE AUTHORITY TO ACT AS AN ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO SERVE CITATIONS AND ZONING VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the Leonardtown Zoning Ordinance provides for the administration and enforcement of the provisions and regulations of said Ordinance, including a requirement that all officers and employees of the town assist the enforcing officer by reporting to him any seeming violations in new construction, reconstruction or land uses, and

WHEREAS, Section 3, Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for the procedures to be followed in the enforcement of municipal ordinances and resolutions, including providing for the authorization by the legislative body of the municipality of an individual or individuals to act as enforcement officers for the purpose of implementing said procedures, and


WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Commissioners of Leonardtown to designate an enforcement officer and to implement the procedures outlined in Section 3, Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of the Leonardtown Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 12th day of December, 1994, that the Commissioners of Leonardtown, hereby adopt and incorporate the provisions of Section 3, Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland for the purpose of enforcement of the Leonardtown Zoning Ordinance, and further hereby appoint the Community Police Officer to act as the enforcement officer to implement said enforcement procedures.


