Business Development Program


RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development has established the Neighborhood Business Development Program (NBDP) providing grants and loans to assist communities in the revitalization and redevelopment of their business districts; and

WHEREAS, on February 12, 1996, the Town Council of Leonardtown established a certain area of the Town as a "designated neighborhood" for the purposes of this grant and loan program; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that NBDP funds would be available to assist in the development of the Tudor Hall Villages project if that property is included in the "designated neighborhood" established by the Town;

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED on this date of August 11, 1997, that the Town Council of Leonardtown hereby amends its "designated neighborhood" map to include that the property known as Tudor Hall Farms as shown on Tax Map 126 as Parcel 228.
