A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW FOR APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN  
THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
COMMUNITY LEGACY GRANT PROGRAM

Resolution of the Commissioners of Leonardtown approving the designation of the Leonardtown Wharf Property as a *Community Legacy* Area and application and receipt of financing for a *Community Legacy* Project in Leonardtown, Maryland to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the community in Leonardtown; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown proposes to (i) designate the area of the Leonardtown Wharf Property in Leonardtown, as outlined on the attached map (the "Area") as a *Community Legacy* Area and to (ii) develop a *Community Legacy* Project in the Leonardtown Wharf Property area, the purpose of which will be to contribute to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area; and

WHEREAS, the Department, either through the *Community Legacy* Program or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other state departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing of the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law, regulations and Departmental requirements necessitate approval of the *Community Legacy* Area designation, the Project and the Project Financing by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, and, where appropriate, by the chief elected executive official of the local subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners of Leonardtown hereby endorses the designation of a *Community Legacy* Area and the Project in the Area; and HEREBY approves the Project Financing in the form of a grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor be, and is hereby requested to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating his approval thereof; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be sent to the Secretary of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that J. Harry Norris, III, Mayor, and Laschelle E. Miller, Town Administrator, are designated as the representatives authorized to execute such application and all other documents in connection therewith.
