

A RESOLUTION of the Council of The Commissioners of Leonardtown to Renew the Cable Television Franchise Ordinance

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 81 of the Leonardtown Code granted a fifteen year cable television franchise to American Cable TV, which was subsequently transferred to Gans Communications, L.P. d/b/a Metrocast Communications ("Metrocast Communications"), set to expire May 31, 2012.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Leonardtown held a public hearing on May 14, 2012 to receive public comment on the Leonardtown Cable Television Franchise held by Metrocast Communications.

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes the quality of service currently provided by Metrocast Communications and enjoyed by Leonardtown residents.

WHEREAS, Metrocast Communications has provided state of the art infrastructure in the Leonardtown area and has committed to continue to provide quality service to the residents of Leonardtown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 2012, The Council of The Commissioners of Leonardtown hereby renews the Cable Television Franchise granted to Metrocast Communications for an additional fifteen years. The new expiration date will be May 31, 2027.






