- ✓ Participants should have an interest in or relationship to the town of Leonardtown.
- ✓ Two- Dimensional (flat) artworks accepted: Drawing, painting, graphics, textiles photography, collage.
- ✓ Works may be made using crayons, pencils, oil pastels, paint, paper, markers, pen and ink and chalk.
- ✓ Original concept, creativity, and historical merit are encouraged.
- ✓ No tracing or dittos. No size limit, framing is optional.

Please include student's name, grade, age, and e-mail address on the back of artwork.

Student artworks will be returned at the end of the year.

First prize winners in each category will be awarded a \$100 Savings Bond by the Commissioners of Leonardtown.
