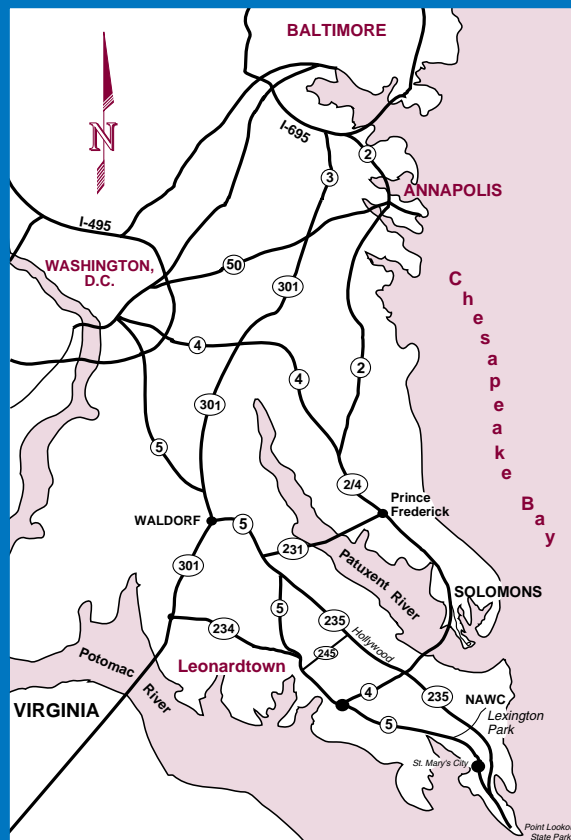


• LOCATION MAP •

Leonardtown boasts an abundance of history and is the county seat for St. Mary's County. Leonardtown is also home to the St. Mary's County Courthouse, and is the center of government for St. Mary's County.

- **Tour** historic Tudor Hall, a Georgian mansion built in 1744, now serving as the headquarters and research center for the St. Mary's County Historical Society.
- **Visit** the Old Jail Museum, which displays artifacts of local history.
- **Observe** two War Memorial Monuments honoring county residents who died in WWI, WWII, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, and the War on Terrorism.
- **Read** "A Most Convenient Place" to capture Leonardtown's history between 1650-1950
